

Carrying any handgun in the chamber immediately in front of the firing pin may cause an accidental discharge. Single action revolvers and some semi-automatic pistols should be carried with the hammer or firing pin resting on an empty chamber. All Galco holsters for the 1911 model/type firearm with safety straps and thumb-breaks are designed to carry the 1911 in the "hammer down, chamber empty condition". Galco 1911 holsters that are "open top" (no safety strap and no thumbbreak) are designed to carry 1911's in all safe "conditions of carry" as specified by the firearm manufacturer.

**TESTING A NEW HOLSTER FOR PROPER HOLSTER AND HANDGUN FIT**

Never place a loaded handgun in a holster without first testing, in an unloaded condition (double-check to make sure the chamber is empty), for proper fit with the handgun. Galco holsters are designed to fit factory equipped handguns. The use of trigger shoes or grip adapters or any modifications to the handgun may cause improper holster fit and accidental discharge. All Galco holsters are designed to function safely and are made for specific handgun models. DO NOT ALTER YOUR GALCO HOLSTER IN ANY WAY, INCLUDING ANY SAFETY DEVICE INCORPORATED IN ANY GALCO PRODUCT TO ACCOMMODATE HANDGUNS OR OTHER EQUIPMENT FOR WHICH THE GALCO PRODUCT WAS NOT DESIGNED OR INTENDED. We have tried to clearly label which holsters offer proper fit for specific handguns. However, continual changes will occur due to the number of handgun makes and models available on the market. Galco will not be responsible for typographical and other human errors that can and do occur. It is the user's responsibility to personally check for holster handgun compatibility using appropriate tensiometer to help retain your firearm. Checking your tension screws each time you use your holster is required as part of a regular safety inspection of your equipment. Applying a small amount of clear nail polish to the threads of the tension units after they have been properly adjusted will minimize screw back-out.

**IMPORTANT FIREARMS SAFETY INFORMATION PLEASE READ PRIOR TO USING GALCO HOLSTERS**

Carrying a firearm is a serious responsibility that requires constant awareness. It is your responsibility to exercise extreme caution during any situation where another individual may attempt to take away your handgun. Law enforcement officers in particular should be familiar with the departmental tactical and procedural guidelines regarding the use and carrying of firearms in close proximity to potentially dangerous individuals.

**FIREARM SECURITY**

Always make sure your gun is fully seated in the holster, activating all auto-and/or manual retention devices (when provided). Retention devices must be used when provided. During vigorous physical activity, including running, you should not rely on your holster's retention capabilities; the gun should be held in place with your hand to prevent the gun from falling out of the holster. We strongly recommend a regular practice routine be utilized to assure the continued capabilities of both product and user.

**FIREARM RETENTION**

You must be certain that your gun is securely seated in the holster each time you holster your firearm before removing your hand from the grip. Firearms must snugly fit in holsters to guard against accidental loss of the handgun. However, a snug fit may cause the slide to go out of battery when holstering. Therefore, you should always place your thumb on the back of the slide to insure that the slide does not go out of battery while holstering. Keep fingers off the trigger and out of the trigger guard when drawing or replacing the handgun in the holster.

**HOLSTERING YOUR FIREARM**

It is the user's responsibility to exercise extreme caution when handling or carrying any handgun and to assume that the gun is loaded. Do not attempt to cock a handgun while it is in the holster. Cocking the handgun while holstered can cause damage to the holster, gun, or both and may cause an accidental discharge. For information on how to safely carry your particular handgun, please refer to your handgun manufacturer's safety and instruction manual.

**SATISFACTION GUARANTEE**


**REPAIRS**

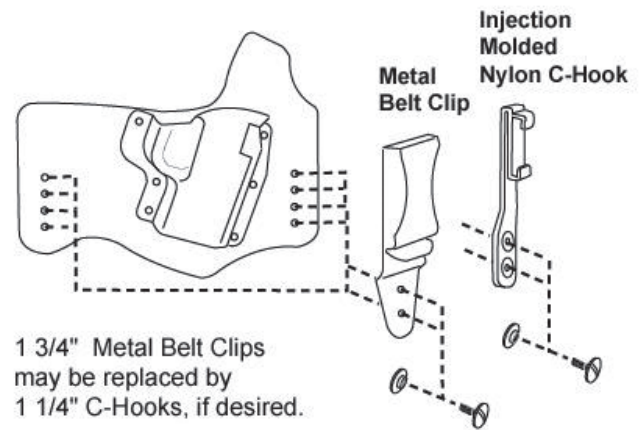

Constructed of a leather backing plate with a Kydex® holster pocket, the patented\* KingTuks provide the best of both worlds: the comfort of a leather IWB with the speed and easy return to holster of a Kydex design.

Worn inside the waistband, the KingTuk's removable metal belt clips (fitting belts up to 1 3/4") can be moved up or down in the corresponding holes in the leather, enabling the user to set the carry height and angle to suit their unique preferences.

Optional, interchangeable injection molded nylon C-Hooks (fitting belts up to 1 1/4" and sold separately) are also available. The C-Hooks offer an even lower profile on the belt, and further increase the KingTuk's already excellent concealability!

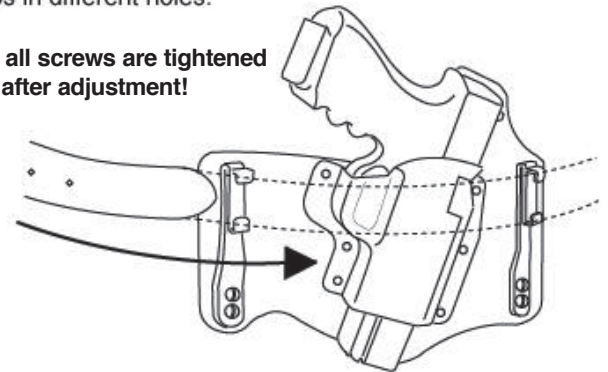

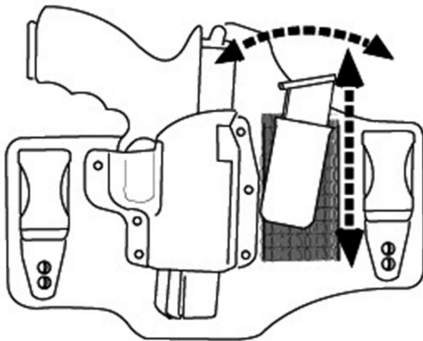
1 3/4" Metal Belt Clips may be replaced by 1 1/4" C-Hooks, if desired.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

The interior of Galco's Kydex holsters will not harm your gun's finish – but dirt and grit trapped inside the holster may. To remove any grit or grime, especially after use in dusty conditions, simply wipe out the interior of the holster using a clean, damp cloth.

### DO

Ensure that all screws are tightened snugly. Applying a small amount of clear nail polish to the threads will minimize screw back-out.

Full grain leather holsters that come in contact with bodily perspiration, the elements, or become soiled on a regular basis may need to be treated periodically to slow the natural breakdown of the leather fibers. Dry the leather naturally, without any type of artificial heat. Use Galco Leather Lotion, which will replace the natural oils in the leather.

### DON'T

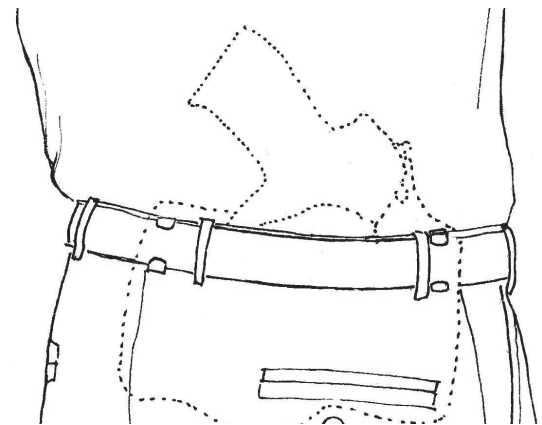
Do not use LocTite® or threadlock. Outgassing from these adhesive compounds will adversely affect plastic, nylon and rubber holster parts.

Do not submerge or saturate your leather product in water or any other liquid or dry your leather product with heat from a hair dryer, oven, radiator, direct sunlight, etc.

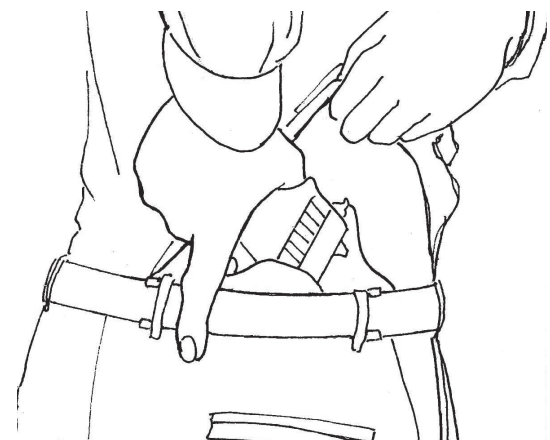
Do not use products such as Neats Foot or Mink oil as they will damage the leather.

Do not leave your leather product on the dashboard of your car in summer, or leave it otherwise exposed to the elements.

The above care and maintenance instructions cannot substitute for your good common sense. Following our recommended care and maintenance tips, along with common sense, will allow you to get the maximum service life from your Galco leather products.
