



Directions for safe use and durability

\*Belt can be worn with the tongue facing left or right.

Use locking carabiners ONLY!

## WARNING!

Improper use may result in serious injury or death, and will result in abusive premature Velcro<sup>®</sup> wear!

To work properly, the loose end of the Original Instructor Belt<sup>™</sup> must be threaded through the buckle and around the floating lock bar, then fastened securely with the hook and loop fasteners. If this is not done properly the belt will not be locked securely and will have no load-bearing capability. In addition, the end tab Velcro® will be damaged and quickly lose its adhesive qualities.



The Original Instructor Belt<sup>™</sup> is designed as a pants belt to be worn for weapons carry and/or as an emergency belt if an emergency evacuation is necessary. This belt should not be used for rappelling without leg loops for proper support. Any rappelling or working from elevated positions should be done only after receiving competent professional instruction in rock climbing and tactical rope use.

When working on an elevated position a locking carabiner should be used to clip into the v-ring on the buckle with no more than five feet of rope slack to limit the distance you could fall. Be sure to lock the sleeve on the carabiner.

Do not tie into a rope which has less tensile strength than 5,000 lbs. The rope should be in undamaged condition and less than five years old. Any rope used should be a dynamic climbing rope with a UIAA rating of three falls minimum.
